On the design front, Falconer says that she's noticed that more and more, people want things fast—she calls it the "HGTV syndrome." She says good planning is essential when it comes to interior design. "It is not just important for the design to be innovative, beautiful, and comfortable, but it needs to be executed in the least painful way. I love drama in a room, but not over a room!" she says.
